- In response to the economic stress of the covid pandemic, St Simon donated approximately 500 food baskets to the poor and those in need, within and around Likas area to both Catholic and non Catholics as well as members from other parishes,, Shan Tao school and NGO Sri Mengasih.
- 30 St Simon Caritas members and parishioners gathered to help pack and deliver the food baskets, each containing 5kg/10kg rice, cooking oil, coffee, flour, sugar, biscuits, dried noodles, meehoon, canned food, milk powder, laundry detergent, powdered health drink Vico, instant noodles and face masks - each valued approximately RM80 - RM100.
- "Most were so grateful to receive the food baskets and expressed their appreciation to the church for helping them," reported person-in-charge Vera Chin.
